Universidad VERITAS - Costa Rica

SUNY Cortland's partnership with Universidad Veritas in Costa Rica allows students to take courses in more than fifteen different areas of study. Students can study Spanish in an immersive environment, or focus on other course areas that are taught in English or Spanish, while living with a host family to get a taste of Costa Rican culture. It is possible to receive between 4 and 8 credits for the summer session, or between 12 and 18 credits for a full semester. Virtual course opportunities are available for Summer 2021, with the hope of resuming in-person study abroad options for Fall 2021 and beyond.






Scholarship Spotlight: Gilman

Gilman International Scholarship Program provides students who receive a Pell grant as part of their college financial aid package with up to \$5,000 to study or intern abroad. The study abroad program must be at least 3 weeks in duration. Virtual study abroad programs will also be considered.
