- 3) In what way will the literacy specialist degree support your long-term professional goal?

Format Directions:

1) Essay should be: typed, double-spaced, 10 – 12 pt font size, preferable font Times New Roman, two or more pages, at least one inch margins, all three questions/statements must be clearly addressed.

Failure to observe format directions will automatically disqualify the essay.
