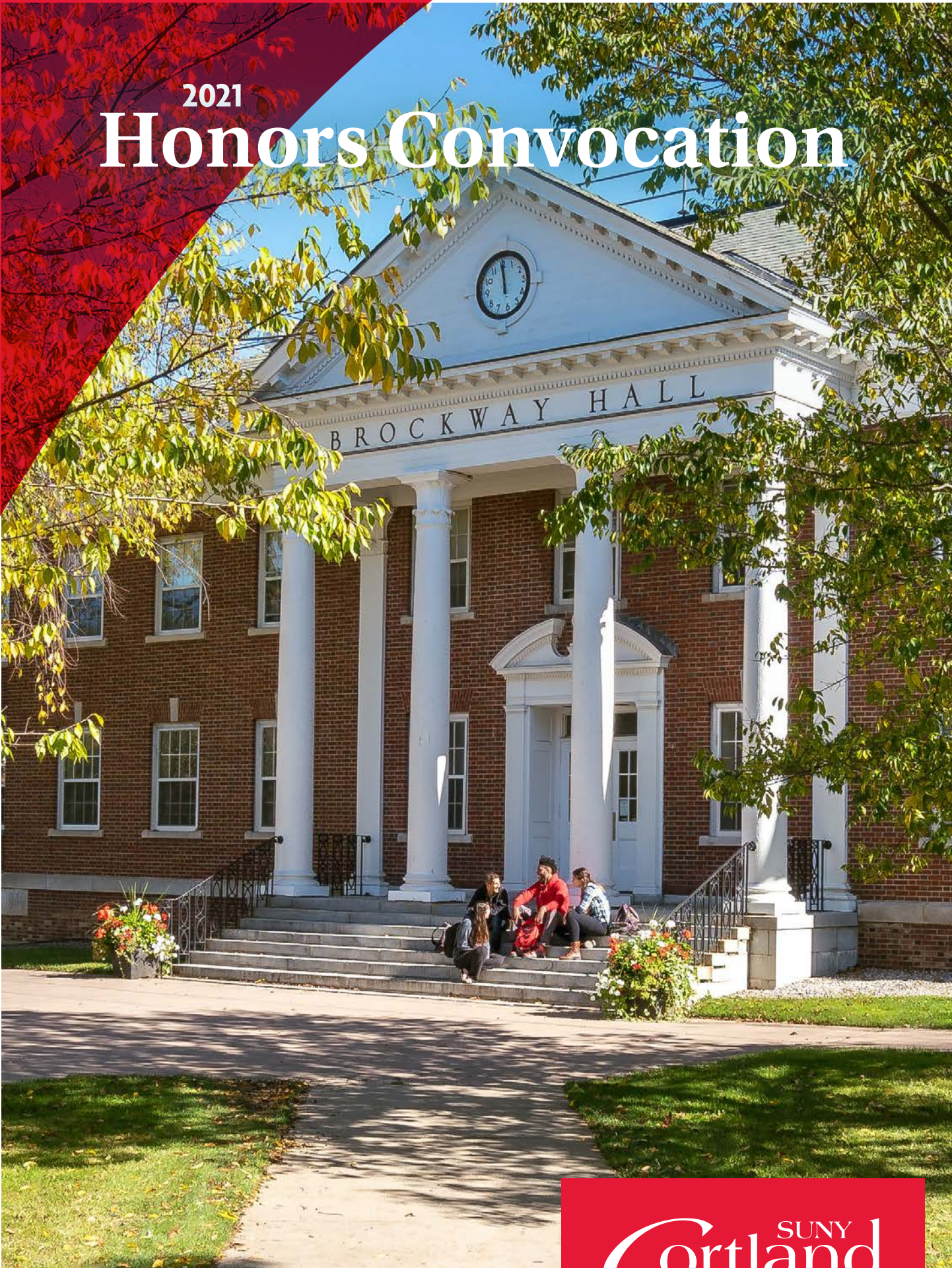

Message From the President

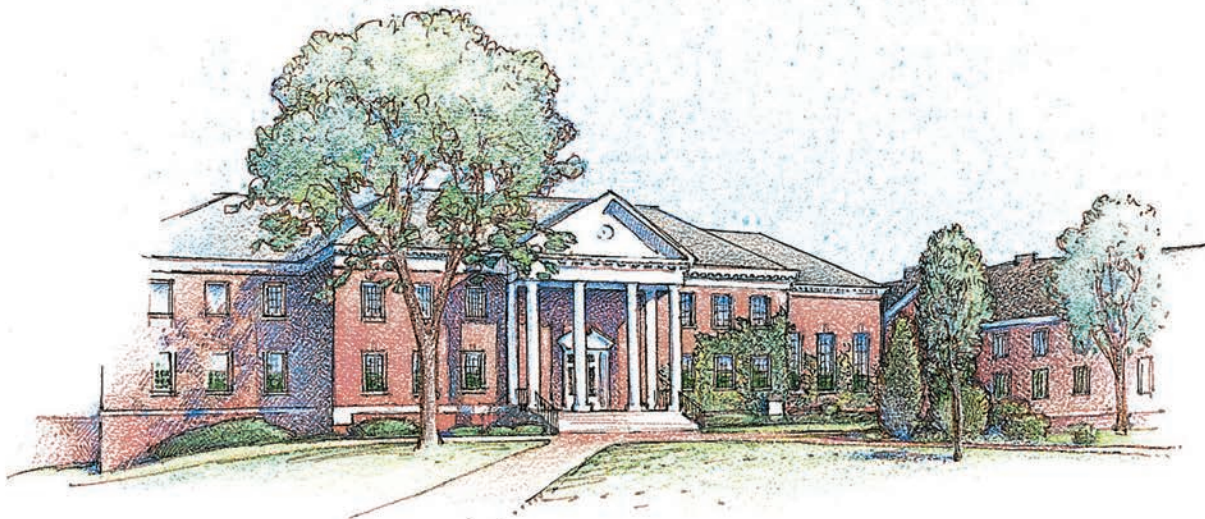
